

FL ID Address Guidance

Client is living in permanent housing (must have 2):

- Household information document - deed, mortgage, monthly mortgage statement, or residential rental/lease agreement
- Florida Voter Registration Card
- Valid Florida Vehicle/Vessel Registration or Title
- Utility bills (dated within the last 60 days)
- Automobile Payment Booklet (dated within the last 60 days)
- Selective Service card (dated within the last 60 days)
- Medical card or bill (dated within the last 60 days)
- Insurance policy or bill (homeowner or automobile) (dated within the last 60 days)
- Employer Documentation (W-2 form or 1099 form, paycheck stub)
- Financial Statements (bank, credit cards, etc) (dated within the last 60 days)
- Government Mail/Documents (dated within the last 60 days)
- Sexual Offender/Sexual Predator/Career Offender: (dated within the last 60 days)
Certification of Address, section A, and the FDLE Registration form completed by the local sheriff's department.

Client is living with somebody else and does not have mail in their own name:

- Completed Certification of Address form (sections A, B, & C) AND 2 proofs of mail in that other person's name (see list on Certification of Address Form, section B). The other person must be notarized on the form or go to the tax collector with the client.

Client is living in a program or shelter (include all of the below):

1. A letter from a homeless shelter, transitional service provider, or half-way house verifying that the client resides at the shelter address (dated within the last 60 days)
2. Certification of Address form (section A only)
3. Certification of Homelessness (if program or shelter provides homeless services)

Client is unhoused & wants General Delivery on their ID:

1. Certification of Address form (section A only)
2. Certification of Homelessness form
